The first edition of *Les 24 Heures du Roman* took place in Canada in October 2015, marking the 400th anniversary of Samuel de Champlain's arrival in North America. Twenty-four French-speaking writers travelled from Halifax to Toronto, working together for 24 hours to write "Sur les traces de Champlain: Une aventure extraordinaire en 24 tableaux." Published in November 2015, the novel has been acclaimed for its literary success and cross-cultural experience.
